## U.S. Certification Bonus Program Frequently Asked Questions

### **October 2017: Explanation of clarification to program:**

- Effective October 1, 2017, the Certification Bonus Program committee agreed to recognize CompTIA Server+ as a Level 3/Level 4 credential option.

### **September 2016:: Explanation of clarification to program:**

Effective September 1, 2016, the Certification Bonus Program committee agreed to recognize CompTIA Cloud+ and VMware Certified Associate to the Level 3 and Level 4 program options.

### **October 2014: Explanation of clarification to program:**

Effective October 1, 2014, the Certification Bonus Program committee agreed to recognize *any* Cisco Certified Networking Associate (CCNA) in Level 3/Level 4 of the bonus program requirements.

- Each individual CCNA credential will be recognized in Level 3/Level 4 as a separate credential as long as it is maintained and current.
- This will give program participants additional options when renewing existing CCNA credentials, as well as, providing more options for new credentials recognized in the program.
- Any additional CCNA's submitted through the current Cisco verification process after October 1st, 2014 will be added to participant profiles.

### **July 2013: Explanation of Updates to program**

- Level 1 & Level 2 – added SSCA (SIP) credential to options
- Level 1 & Level 2 – added AIPS Avaya Credential as options (in some cases the AIPS replaces the ACIS as determined by Avaya Learning.
- Level 3 & Level 4 – added CompTIA Security+ and Cisco CCNA Security+ to options.

### **January 2013: Explanation of Updates to program**

- Level 1 & Level 2 – removed requirement for a minimum of 1 Avaya Credential
- Level 1 now requires only 2 items
- Level 2 now requires only 3 items
- Grace period until 6/7/2014 to meet new level 1 & 2 requirements, if required.

### **December 2011: Explanation of Updates to program**

- Avaya Data is now known as Avaya Networking
- (MTA) Windows Server Administration Fundamentals added to Level 3 and 4 as an alternative for the MCTS 2003/2008.
- CS1K Exam added to Level 1 and 2 options for Avaya Cert requirement.

### **October 2010: Explanation of Updates to program**

- Avaya ACIS credentials added to program for SME, UC, UM & DATA to satisfy minimum “Avaya Cert” requirement for Level 1 and Level 2.

### **January 2010: Explanation of Updates to Program:**

- New dollar amounts per level go into effect across the board for FY11 (Oct 1, 2010), but those who achieve an ACSS prior to 10/1/2011, will be paid according to the new program dollars on a pro-rated basis.
- New Avaya Certification Options
  - The **ACA** (Avaya Certified Associate) is no longer available for achievement
  - The existing **ACS** (Avaya Certified Specialist) will be valid in this program, and will be available to attain until the associated **ACSS** becomes available in 2010.
  - The new **ACSS** certifications are accepted going forward, these will become available throughout FY10.
    - **IP Office** is now called **SME** (Small and Medium Enterprise)
    - **IP Telephony** is now called **UC** (Unified Communications)
    - **Modular Messaging** is now called **UM** (Unified Messaging)

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q: When I look at my AU transcript, my ACA says it expires on September 30, 2010. I thought in this program my ACA expiration date would be pushed out to January 31, 2011.**

**A:** You are right, you will get credit for your ACA through 1/31/2011 and in fact, the 60 day grace period will also apply if you complete your new ACSS by 3/30/2011. Because we cannot change the AU Transcripts for this program, we will build the date extension into our logic for Level achievement and Bonus Payout calculations. You can view your status on the [Certification Program Website](#).

**\*\*updated with 2013 Amendment, retired ACAs recognized through 6/7/2014. After 6/7/2014, retired ACAs are no longer recognized in the program.**

**Q: Where can I find more information on the Avaya Certification program updates?**

**A:** All Avaya Certification information is available on the Avaya Learning website, <http://www.avaya-learning.com> under the Learning & Certification menu, Credential Program, Implementation & Support Credentials.

**Q: Which versions of the Communication Networking Exam are accepted in this program?**

**A:** CNE 132-S-100.3R 132-S-100.1XR.

**Q: Will I need to take the ACIS/ACSS exam at a testing center?**

**A:** Yes, all ACIS & ACSS exams are proctored exams and need to be scheduled at a VUE testing center <http://www.vue.com/avaya/>

**Q: Do I need a voucher to take the Avaya ACIS/ACSS exams? How do I pay for that?**

**A:** All Avaya proctored exams are delivered through Person-VUE. Prior to registering for an exam, you MUST obtain a discount voucher with your manager's approval by sending your name, HRID, e-mail, exam number and name and expected date to test to [tthibeault@avaya.com](mailto:tthibeault@avaya.com).

**Q: If I already have the MCP in Server 2000 or Server 2003, do I need to take the new Microsoft MCTS certification?**

**A:** No, the MCP exams will continue to meet the Microsoft requirement in Levels 3 and 4 of this program and they do not expire.

**Q: I am one of the most senior employees in my workgroup, will I be offered first opportunity for certification training?**

**A:** Yes, training opportunities are offered by seniority within your work group.

**Q: What are the semi-annual periods for the Certification Program and when will the payouts occur?**

**A:** There are two certification periods per year. The first one will begin October 1<sup>st</sup> and end March 31<sup>st</sup>. The payout for this period will occur by June. The second period will begin April 1<sup>st</sup> and end on September 30<sup>th</sup> and the payout will occur by December. As long as the individual maintains his/her certifications, the bonus payouts will continue to occur every six months equal to their level.

**Q: If I hold valid industry certifications for the whole certification period, but I don't get my certifications verified (and entered into the tool) until half-way through the period, how will this affect my payout?**

**A:** Your certifications are valid from the date you achieved them, not the date they get verified or entered into our system; therefore, you will be paid for the entire six month period.

**Q: How long will it take for my Industry Certifications to show up in the certification tool once I have verified them?**

**A:** Once we have received the authentication e-mail from the vendor, it will take 1 to 2 weeks to update your record in the tool and re-calculate your current level.

## U.S. Certification Bonus Program

### Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: If I decline to participate in the certification program, will I still get a semi-annual bonus if I qualify for a Level?**

**A:** Yes, you will still qualify for a semi-annual bonus. If you decline participation in the program, you are giving up your right to be considered for certification training based on your seniority (meaning that someone less senior who is participating in the program could take your place in a training course geared toward this certification program).

**NOTE:** Make sure that if you hold any industry certifications covered in this program that you follow the verification process to get them into our system otherwise you might be foregoing your correct bonus entitlement.

**Q: I would like to change my enrollment status on the website, but the website will not allow me to change my status after my initial enrollment. How do I do this?**

**A:** Please contact one of the Union Coordinators listed on the website and let them know what you would like to do – they will discuss your options with you and help you get your record updated appropriately.
